**AUTHORIZATION FOR TREATMENT:** The above mentioned student is permitted to be treated with the following first aid supplies: Hydrogen Peroxide, calamine lotion, antibiotic ointment, insect sting antiseptic. When needed, all prescription and over-the-counter medication, in original containers, labeled with the child's name in a Ziploc bag, must be brought to the office to be kept in a locked cabinet. These will only be dispensed as indicated with written permission. If your child has allergies or a life threatening medical condition, a Medical Care Plan form must be completed before the child can attend camp (form available in the office).

*Your child may be photographed or videotaped while in a camp for school publications or for local media such as TV or newspaper.*
