Application Fee: \$50.00 (Non-refundable) - One-time fee for students new to St. Mark's, due at application.

Testing Fee: \$50.00 (Non-refundable) - One-time fee for Pre-K II through sixth grade students new to St. Mark's, due at testing.

Enrollment Deposit:

The **non-refundable** enrollment deposit is applied toward tuition and is due at the time of enrollment.

Supply and Activity Fee:

This fee includes student supplies, workbooks, use of textbooks and software, field trips, and other activities. It does not include a yearbook, Singapore Math summer tutoring for new students, nor expenses for overnight field trips in fifth and sixth grades. The optional lunch program is billed separately.

Fifth and sixth grade overnight field trips anticipated costs: The fifth grade overnight trip will cost approximately \$1,400.

The sixth grade overnight trips will cost approximately \$1,000. Prices may vary due to number of students and fluctuations in travel costs.

Trip costs are billed in 10 monthly increments from May to February.

Tuition Refund Plan Premium (Optional):

The Tuition Refund Plan is a means to ensure your financial obligation under the terms of the Enrollment Contract. Students are enrolled for the academic year, and **no adjustment of fees can be made by the school for absences, withdrawals, or dismissals**. The plan covers required tuition payments in the event of medical absence or withdrawal (100% of remaining tuition), or non-medical withdrawal (50% of remaining tuition). Please read the plan's brochure for a full description. The premium for the Tuition Refund Plan is billed by the school in August and must be paid within ten days from the first class day of the academic year. Parents are reminded **no refund can be made**, except as provided under this plan. It is understood **students are enrolled for the entire school year**, or such portion as may remain after the date of entrance. The fact the school fees are paid in two or more installments does not constitute a fractional contract.

Tuition Payment Schedules

You may choose to pay tuition according to three time schedules:

1. Annual Payment: Due May 1, 2012
2. Semi-Annual Payments: Due May 1, 2012 and October 1, 2012
3. Ten Monthly Payments: Beginning May 1, 2012

Payment Methods

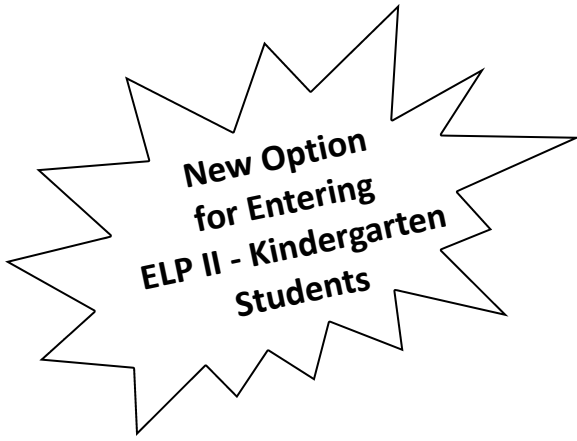
You may pay tuition by cash, check, or through your banking institution's online bill pay service. Paperless statements are provided each month online.

Absences and Withdrawals

No adjustment of tuition or fees can be made by the school for absences. A written request for a withdrawal must be received by the Director of Enrollment two weeks prior to the withdrawal. Any unpaid balance is due upon the student's withdrawal.

Early Morning Care 7:15 a.m. - 8 a.m.

Care is available beginning at 7:15 a.m. for Early Learning Program students, at no charge, after the initial Extended Day Program registration fee of \$30 per child has been paid, and the Extended Day registration form is completed and returned.
